The Winnetka Historical Society is accepting applications for unpaid interns for Fall/Winter - Spring 2018 to assist with the Winnetka Buildings Research Project. This position will report to the curator of collections and the executive director.

The intern will assist in a community-wide survey of the existing building stock in the Village. Interns will photograph structures, conduct historical research in the Village of Winnetka and WHS building files, and record and update findings into the master survey document. The intern will also research significant structures and architects.

The ideal candidate will be enrolled in a graduate program in Architecture, Historic Preservation, Public History, Museum Studies, or similar field of study. Attention to detail, ability to work independently, and knowledge of architectural styles strongly desired.
